## THE GOALS OF THE AFGLC-ICHS AT RSCNJ:

The Center, through its programs, will provide enrichment opportunities for both students and faculty at RSCNJ and will facilitate contacts with other programs and scholars in the United States and abroad. In order to achieve and fulfill its mission, the ICHS shall:

- apply for funding from granting agencies external to the RSCNJ,
- help to establish interdisciplinary degree programs at RSCNJ relating to various aspects of Hellenism at the undergraduate and graduate levels,
- advise students wishing to pursue careers in Hellenic studies,
- utilize the internet and other distance learning technologies as they relate to its mission,
- participate and contribute to the AFGLC academic journal, devoted to all aspects of Hellenism.

## THE AFGLC-ICHS AT RSCNJ:

The ICHS has been established by the American Foundation for Greek Language and Culture(AFGLC). Its mission is similar to that of the AFGLC-ICHS model Center developed at the University of South Florida. The Foundation has been

established by academics and other professionals across America, who came together to assist in the preservation and enhancement of Greek culture and language through institutions of higher learning. In so doing, the AFGLC hopes to make clear to both present and future generations the fundamental importance of the Hellenic tradition to Americans of all backgrounds.
